Since the announcement of lock down due to spread of global pandemic COVID-19, schools along with industry and business were closed following the orders of State Govt. However, BCM School, Chandigarh Road didn't let studies be hindered even for a single day. Through a well-structured home based educational program - 'Digital Remote Learning', teachers transitioned to virtual class rooms and continued imparting online lessons.

New academic session began on 3 April 2020 and the students had a never before experience of meeting their new teachers virtually and learning not only in academics but in co-curricular activities as well. Teachers continued enhancing their competency through varied webinars/workshops offered by CBSE, Centre of Excellence to improve online learning experience for the students.

If the Govt. permits opening of the school, students shall attend the regular classes from 11 July 2020. We have also scheduled a summer camp for the students of Classes IV -VIII to be conducted between 8-18 June wherein children shall do physical exercise and sharpen their art, music and life skills. The details are enclosed herewith.
